Greetings Metrc Integration Providers,

Effective October 24, 2019, the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) processed a license number conversion for all cultivation licenses. This renumbering effort impacts all third-party vendors that support California Cultivators in Metrc.

Please work with your licensees to make all necessary License Number changes in your software to accommodate this conversion.

Plant and Package UID Tags

Cultivators are allowed to use their current inventory of plant and package tags. Packages received from cultivators may continue to be assigned tags that display the old license number prefix (CALyy-, CMLyy-, PALyy-, and PMLyy-) until the cultivator uses up their current inventory of tags and orders new tags.
